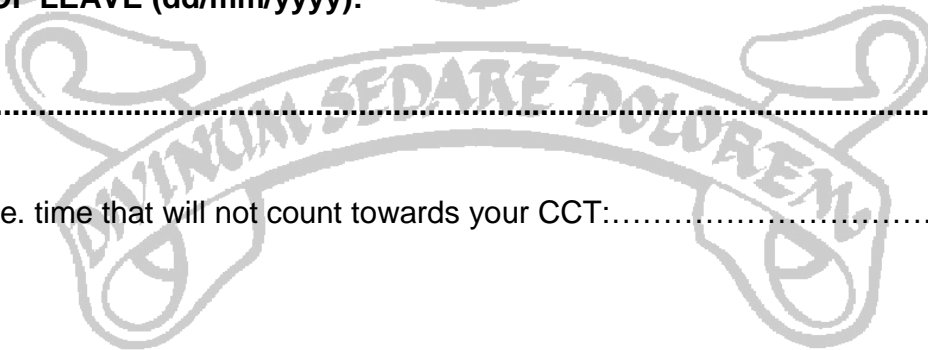

- If you met your objectives and how. If not, what were the reasons for this and how could this have been changed/achieved.
